CLASSES

Beginners- Riders who are just off a lead line and can only just walk let alone trot. Led riders may compete in this class but they can't place above an unaided rider.

Improvers- A bit better than beginners, can walk and trot but find it very hard to canter.

Novice- Can walk, trot and canter (holding on to the saddle) better than improvers but not quite capable. A bit of a greenhorn when it comes to Oldies Days.

Capable- Competent riders who do not compete often, (maybe the odd competition here and there over the years) Able to walk trot & canter with confidence.

Experienced- Riders who compete regularly and are confident and proficient riders.

Open- Riders who compete and place regularly in Gymkhanas, sporting or camp-drafting, etc...

Rules & Conditions of Entry

1. All events are run according to the PCAQ rules and gear check book however, PCAQ membership not required
2. One horse one rider, one rider one horse.
3. All riders must wear scull caps (ASA3838 or better) with chin straps in all events.
4. All competitors are asked to be honest about their ability when nominating, judges will move rider if they need
5. Judges decision is final. Any disputes to be lodged in writing with a \$40.00 fee within 30 minutes of completion of the event
6. Competitors leaving their group or riding in a dangerous manner outside the ring will be disqualified for the day.
7. Dummy Spurs only may be worn and excessive use of whip or spurs will result in elimination.
8. No dogs allowed on grounds - DPI rules.
9. Bad language or disrespect to the judges, stewards or pencilers will not be tolerated, nor will ill treatment of horses.
10. In the event of a tie in the overall points, a count back will be made to determine the winner.
11. No liquor of any sort will be allowed on the grounds.
12. Management committee reserves the right to amend the program or events.
